

## ECHA Updates List of Intentions for Restrictions under REACH Annex XVII

The European Chemical Agency (ECHA) updated its registry of restriction intentions. Listed substances might be restricted in future under REACH Annex XVII.



### Background

On April 3<sup>rd</sup> 2019, the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA) updated its registry of restriction intentions. Listed substances will be further investigated to prove whether a restriction under REACH Annex XVII will be implemented.

Name	Proposed scope
Calcium cyanamide	Restriction of the use of calcium cyanamide as a fertilizer.
Lead chromate; Lead sulfochromate yellow (C.I. Pigment Yellow 34); Lead chromate molybdate sulphate red (C.I. Pigment Red 104)	Restriction in articles that contain lead chromate substances.
microplastics	Restriction of use of intentionally added microplastic particles to consumer or professional use products.
Tris(2-chloroethyl) phosphate (TCEP) Tris[2-chloro-1-(chloromethyl)ethyl] phosphate (TDCEP) tris(2-chloro-1-methylethyl) phosphate (TCPP) and certain reaction masses	Restriction in childcare articles and residential upholstered furniture with PUR foams. Restriction may cover mattresses for adults and textiles as well.
formaldehyde and formaldehyde releasers	Restriction of formaldehyde and formaldehyde releasers in mixtures and articles for consumer uses.
Octamethylcyclotetrasiloxane (D4); Decamethylcyclopentasiloxane (D5); dodecamethylcyclohexasiloxane (D6)	Restriction in leave on personal care products and other consumer/professional products (e.g. dry cleaning, waxes and polishes, washing and cleaning products).
PAH (8 substances)	Restriction in plastic, rubber and other granules, as infill material on synthetic turf pitches or for use as loose granules or mulch on playgrounds and sport applications.
Cobalt carbonate; Cobalt di(acetate); Cobalt dichloride; Cobalt dinitrate; Cobalt sulphate	Restriction in certain chemicals and use of professional and industrial use.
N,N-dimethylformamide	Restriction of use of the substance on its own or in mixtures in a concentration equal or greater than 0.3% to protect workers.
Diisocyanates	Restriction of use or placed on the market as substances or in mixtures for industrial and professional uses, with some exemptions.
Undecafluorohexanoic acid	Restriction of substance, in mixture and in articles
(3,3,4,4,5,5,6,6,7,7,8,8,8-tridecafluorooctyl) silanetriol and any of its mono-, di- or tri-O-(alkyl) derivatives	Restriction in sprays used for the general public.
Perfluorooctanoic acid and its salts	Derogation for the import and use in certain pharmaceutical products in entry 68 of Annex XVII
